<u>Biography</u>

Jerome A. Diekemper graduated from St. Louis University School of Law in 1971. After one year as a Field Examiner and Field Attorney for the Region 14 office of the National Labor Relations Board in St. Louis, Jerry was in private practice representing unions and individual employees in labor and employment matters for 34 years.

Since October of 1993, Jerry has mediated over 1600 civil cases of all types, except domestic relations matters. Approximately two-thirds of these cases were employment matters. He tried 250 arbitrations as an advocate and has over 100 cases as an arbitrator.

Jerry has been included in every edition of the Best Lawyers in America since 1983. In the 2009 edition, he was listed in the areas of Alternative Dispute Resolution and Labor and Employment Law. In 2011, he was named the best labor and employment lawyer in St. Louis and in 2013 as the best arbitrator. In the November 2006 and 2007 Editions of Missouri and Kansas Super Lawyers, Jerry was included in the Top 100 list of Missouri-Kansas lawyers and the Top 50 list of St. Louis lawyers.
