## Sidney S. Eagles, Jr.

N.C. Court of Appeals Chief Judge Sidney S. Eagles, Jr. has joined the Raleigh office of Smith Moore LLP.

Prior to his election to the bench, Judge Eagles was in private practice in Raleigh. He was Counsel to the Speaker of the House and earlier had been a Special Deputy Attorney General. He argued cases regularly before the N.C. Court of Appeals and the Supreme Court, and he also has argued in the Fourth Circuit U.S. Court of Appeals and the Supreme Court of the United States. For more than 25 years, he has been an adjunct professor at Campbell University's School of Law, and he has lectured at numerous legal seminars.

He served from 1970 until 1982 as Secretary, Draftsman and Member of the Criminal Code Commission. He also served as head of the Attorney General's Legislative Drafting Service.
